

Comfort and Joy jar or box

Why not make a Comfort and Joy jar or box for someone you love, or who you think might be lonely.



Recycle a small box or jar and decorate it around the sides and lid (if it has one).

Then measure the dimensions (size) of a piece of card that will go into the jar or box. For example if your box is 5" x 7", cut lots of pieces of card out which measure $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$.

If your jar has a diameter of 4" then cut your card $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$.

Decorate all the cards with either a nice message for the person who are going to give it to;

A lovely bright picture;

A happy poem or verse;

A Bible verse from previous week's activities or a verse from the Christmas story, or Mary's song from Luke's Gospel;

As a last card you could get a photograph of yourself and write what you like about them and what they mean to you.
